Ukraine: Missionary Tammy Swailes asked for prayer for Pastor Elena Kulakova, who has been suffering from the effects of high blood pressure. According to Tammy, Pastor Elena has had serious bouts with high blood pressure and needs the Lord's healing touch. Also, Tammy is joining Pastor Elena's church in helping to purchase some essentials for a family with four kids who lost their father. The mother, Ira, works but it's hard for her to support such a large family. Please pray for Pastor Elena's healing and for Ira and her four children.

Cambodia: Christmas in Cambodia! Missionary Roger Cox shares that in his original conversations with National Missionaries Ly and Sarin Mak, that they were expecting about 300 people to show up for the 2021 Christmas celebration at the Lifesong Learning Center on December 26th. However, two hours before the service started people started lining up outside the gate. By the time they were ready to start the special service there were almost 1,000 people in attendance, including over 100 adults. Both Brother Ly and Mabb, who is pastor Ly's assistant, shared the Christmas story and the Gospel to those in attendance. Mabb told Roger that when people were offered salvation several hands were raised. The Mabs will begin following up with those people and develop disciples for Jesus. Praise God that He always has a plan. Ly and Sarin were obedient to open up the Center for the Christmas gathering, and they had no idea what kind of response they would have, but God put all the pieces in place and 1,000 souls heard the Gospel and were blessed all because of obedience.
