**Trinidad:** The Open Bible Standard Churches of Trinidad and Tobago began to celebrate their 70th Anniversary on Sunday, January 28. Their desire was to celebrate a movement that began 70 years ago when Open Bible USA missionaries first came to this nation. Furthermore, there is a hunger to light a new fire that penetrates every corner of this country, the Caribbean and the world.



A two and a half mile prayer walk took place on

Sunday, which ended with a rally at the San Fernando Open Bible. In the celebration there were big sound trucks that played music, people handed out gospel pamphlets, and there was a prayer stand on the corner where Open Bible started for the first time in Trinidad.

Huge tents were set up in the church parking lot for the overflow crowd. The event was planned for 3,000 people to join the celebration but 4,867 people gathered from all over Trinidad and Tobago. Worship, prayer, and an inspiring bilingual message from Rev. Benjamin Agard challenged the crowd to press for a greater harvest. The enthusiasm, unity, and anointing in the presence of God sparked a passion to advance the kingdom of God. It is worth noting that the praise and adoration of God was raised by thousands of people in the same streets that in two weeks will be filled with Carnival revelers.
