Guinea: Missionaries Tom and Sherry Moore express: "Please pray for Guinea! A couple of years ago there was a military coup to overthrow the president who had changed the constitution so he could have a third term as president. The president was not assassinated, during the coup, he was simply removed and kept in custody for a time. He has since been released.

"The military leader, who took over the government, promised to install a civilian president by the end of 2024. Last week, due to corruption, the president dismissed all government ministers, starting with the prime minister. He will replace them all. Our people in Guinea have told us that the country has remained basically calm. Please pray that calm continues and that there is no more political unrest. Please pray for wisdom for the current military president.

The president has helped the country's infrastructure a lot! He seems to have a good heart and wants to help Guinea resist corruption.

"Please continue to pray for our church leaders. They need God's protection and wisdom as they face several difficult church issues."
