Parents often don't have the money to treat malaria when it occurs. On another note, they give glory to God that now the fence is put up around the campus. They only have 310 feet left fence the entire campus.

Cambodia: Missionaries Roger and Connie Cox have left for Cambodia and will be arriving today. One of their goals for this trip will be preparing for future vision trips in March and July of 2023. Roger and Connie are very excited to have found a qualified person to translate INSTE Level 1 into the Cambodian language of Khmer. We are finalizing the details and Putthy Ly, who is our new translator, is excited to get started on this new project. Funds still need to be raised to complete the first four INSTE books. Please pray for Roger and Connie during their time in Cambodia as they coordinate plans with Ly and Sarin Mak for the future work there.

Thailand: Missionaries Mike and Dara Rasavanh shared, "Praise God that arrived in Thailand safely early Wednesday morning of last week. We had been under the weather on the way here and now we recuperating and ready to pick up where we left off.

On the weekend, we met with a group of Taidam believers from Vietnam, Laos, and Thailand. We discussed future church planting in Taidam communities. We are excited about what God is doing. Doors are opening in the country of Laos and Vietnam. Please continue to pray that we will have favor with the government and the people as we move forward towards our goals. Also pray for our safety as we will be traveling again to visit churches to witness, train leaders, and encourage them in the faith. We appreciate your partnership in prayer and financial support. Venezuela: Field Director Benjamin Agard of Open Bible churches in Trinidad & Tobago shared with us that in the Open Bible church in Ciudad Bolivar, Venezuela, 117 people recently got baptized.
