Guinea: Missionaries Tom and Sherry Moore shared: “Please pray for our missionary colleagues in Guinea who are with the Pioneer Bible Translators. In the morning on Thursday, November 3, we received the news that one of their missionaries, Katie, a young wife and mother, passed away in her sleep. She and her husband worked in the Baga village of Kawass. They are part of the team who has translated the Scriptures into the Baga language. The Bagas are the largest people group that we work with. There was no way for her body to be sent home. On Monday, November 7, two of our Baga pastors led a celebration of life service for her and she was buried in Kawass on their mission property. The service was streamed for her family and colleagues in the U.S. and around the world. Please pray for her husband, Kyle, and their two children, a six-year-old son and seven-year-old daughter. Please pray for protection around the children and for Kyle as he has decisions to make concerning their future.”

El Salvador: Field Director Angel Isidro Diaz updated us and wants to thank everyone who prayed for his wife, Vilma Yanira Hernandez. Her surgery went well, and recovery is going well. He said, “Thank you all for your prayers and glory to God for His love and mercy.”

Des Moines: Pray for Areli Estrada, the executive assistant for Global Missions, who continues to recover from her recent surgery.

Thailand: Missionaries Mike and Dara Rasavanh shared: “We are leaving for the Myanmar mountain border for a four-day outreach. After a four-hour drive, we will be traveling two more hours by boat to get to the mountain village. We will be ministering to the people and bringing some winter clothes for them. There is no internet signal there. Please pray for travel mercy and a productive mission.”

Nigeria: Okon Obot asks us to pray for their annual national convention that will take place November 17-20. The theme is The Wonders of the New Creation. Pray for the Lord’s anointing and blessing upon all activities and services of this convention.

Ukraine: On Sunday, November 20, Missionary Tammy Swailes will be traveling to Poland to present her documentation for her visa for Ukraine. Pray for a safe trip and that Tammy will be able to obtain her new visa without difficulty.
