When she starts attending the university next January, she will continue teaching English and be a part time teacher aid for second grade to continue to help the ministry here at Lifesong. Recently in October, we ministered to a family that lives on the outskirts of a village, and they hardly ever leave their home. They also had heard about Lifesong but were afraid to come to the Center. Now by the grace of God, the family will be attending our worship services. We have been going to visit their home up to three times a week to study the Bible and guide them in their walk with the Lord. When they gave their life to the Lord, they understood that their lives only belong to the Lord and allowed a group of our members to pray over them and their home. They allowed us to clear an altar they had and removed the shrine from their home and burned it.
