We thank God for bringing us through 2021! God had His hand on our trip to Guinea at the beginning of the year. His work continues to go forward under the leadership of our new

executive committee. There are decisions being made to advance the Lord's work by making plans to train some lay leaders, who can then start cell groups in different areas. People are hungry to learn more about Jesus and the HOPE that He brings! Please pray for President Jean Bangoura as he develops the plans for this training program.



Pastor Jean's wife, Celine, has been going to visit some of the pastors' wives and church women in the neighboring villages. She teaches them from the Word, encourages them in their walk with the Lord, and helps them learn different things they can do to help themselves, their



families, and the local church. Years ago Sherry taught her how to do hand embroidery and to crochet. She is now teaching the ladies how to do this work. They are making pretty tablecloths to use at home or in the church. They enjoy this special learning time just for them!

Before our schools reopened in October, the Kamsar Anastasis School painted all the buildings and fixed the outhouse toilets and worked on the schoolyard. This school has almost 800 students, most of whom are Muslim children. As we visited some churches in Iowa and Ohio during the month of October, one church put together small backpacks of



school supplies for us to take with us when we return, for three months in



2022. We were presented with a suitcase full of these school supplies to help bless some of the students who work extra hard in school!

There have been several marriages, baby dedications, and baptisms during the year. Right now the churches are preparing for their special Christmas Eve and Christmas Day services. There will be lots of special music, and usually a big rice meal is shared on Christmas Day. There are believers who will be baptized on Christmas Day, so they will always remember when they made a public stand to follow Jesus!





Thank you for your faithful prayers and giving to help the Lord's work in Guinea among the Muslim people! There are still Muslims coming to Jesus, one by one, and WE ARE GRATEFUL! We will be flying back to Guinea on January 31st, for three months. Please pray for a safe trip and that everything will be accomplished that needs to be. We plan to build a village church and drill wells as finances are available.
