Since having moved back to Cambodia in 2011 to follow the calling God placed in our hearts, our hearts are drawn toward the very poor children who live far away from the city that need a better school system. God helped us obtain the school license in 2022, just as He promised He would. He has provided and many children are enrolled. We are always praising God for His love and protection from all harm and evil.





As time passes, the Lifesong Learning Center in Tamada Village, Cambodia, gets busier. We provide school classes and many activities for the children that God has blessed us with. The children come to learn and spend time with the staff, who give them love that they do not find anywhere, not even at home.

When the doors to the Center open at 6:00 a.m. there are

children already waiting outside to get in. The afternoon classes start at 1:00 p.m. Many afternoon class children come at 11:00 a.m. to play because no one is home to take care of them. Most of them do not eat at home and we feed them. Some children are neglected by their parents. Some come to school with their heads full of lice and we wash and clean out their hair to get rid of the lice.
