
### 2023 Hunsaker Fall Newsletter

It is a 16 foot by 24 foot structure. This team brings in a trailer full of their own supplies each year. They install a bathroom, laundry room, and fully equipped kitchen. Their main focus while here is building the house and the team's relationship with the family.











## **Sunshine Open Bible Church** *Led by Ted Smith and Bill Padgett*

Sunshine Open Bible team from Des Moines, Iowa, comes every other year and has a big heart to bless families with a Puente house. They do an exceptional job of involving everyone, including the family the house is built for. The team also takes time to minister locally in Tijuana.











#### **Missouri on a Mission**

"Missouri on a Mission" is a multi-church group, spearheaded by Open Bible Praise Center in Booneville, Missouri. That's right, we had to remove the houses they lived in to make room for the 28 foot by 40 foot church that will be completed this fall of 2023. just contacted us at Puente de Amistad to ask us for a home for a lady. The lady is a member of his church and had just lost her husband in an explosion that also destroyed their home. Pastor also shared that one year ago that month, her only son was hit by a car and passed away.

If this team had committed to building a house sooner, they would have already been partnered with a family for the year. I know it was the Lord and His perfect plan that was taking place!
