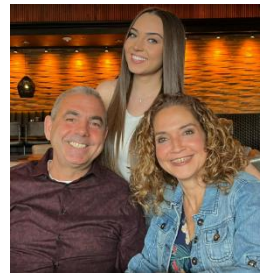
## Prayer and Praise – January 28, 2026

Her one-year-and-four-month-old son was with her in the car, and by God's grace, he was unharmed.



Although doctors are scheduled to perform surgery this coming Friday to stop the bleeding in her brain, Thammy is doing well. The drainage tubes have been removed, she has been moved to a regular hospital room, and the baby she is carrying is also doing well.
