Guinea, Africa: Missionaries Tom and Sherry Moore rejoice as significant progress is being made on two church projects. In Madina Borboffe, the foundation of the new church is complete, and walls are set to begin next week. The congregation, led by Pastor Jean Loua, is currently meeting in a church member’s home and is excited to see their long-awaited building becoming a reality.

In the village of Kawass, the first stone has been laid for a new church plant that began in October 2025 under Pastor Edouard and Josephine Bangoura. Construction is starting with a hangar to provide shelter for services, which will later be developed into a permanent church building as God provides.

The Moores are deeply grateful for your faithful support to the Open Bible ministry in Guinea over the years and ask for continued prayer for the pastors, leaders, and congregations.

Tijuana Mexico: Missionaries Zac Anderson, Justus Morgan, and Michaela Morgan shared that over the weekend, a youth conference took place in the Terrazas neighborhood of Tijuana, Mexico, where a local feeding kitchen is impacting many young people alongside a visiting team from Canada.



Zac, representing Puente de Amistad, was invited to speak at the conference, where God moved powerfully. The event was marked by meaningful worship and celebration, and many young people gave their lives to Christ.

Meanwhile, the outreach of Puente de Amistad continues to expand, building connections with more churches in the region. While Zac ministered at the conference, Justus, Michaela, and Haddy welcomed a team from Creekside Christian School in Rapid City, South Dakota.

This testimony reflects how God is actively working through Puente de Amistad, transforming lives and drawing people to Christ.

Trinidad: The Global Missions Board recently attended the Missions Conference hosted by the Local Evangelism and Foreign Missions (L.E.F.M.) of the Open Bible Churches of Trinidad & Tobago. The gathering was especially meaningful as key leaders from Grace Open Bible Churches of Taiwan—including Field Director Victor Pan and his wife Victoria, along with Pastor Janet and her husband James—were present to assist in launching the first Chinese Open Bible Church in Trinidad.

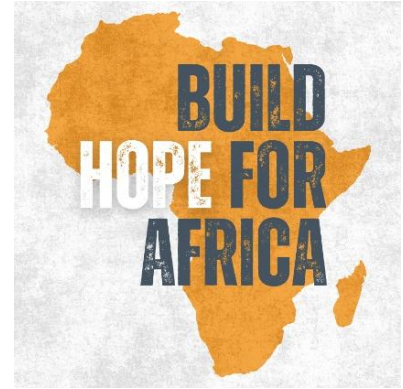
