West Africa: Missionary Andy* shared: "We praise God for the success of INSTE's Swahili leadership training in Tanzania last week. Charles Omina, Bishop of Open Bible Kenya, and I led the training. Fifteen men and women from a church in Tanzania received the training. We believe that in the coming years, hundreds of churches, including Open Bible churches in Kenya and Uganda, will benefit from INSTE Level One in Swahili. God willing, many lives will be transformed for His glory. Thank you for your prayers and support for the ongoing Swahili translation and the INSTE Africa training team."



Tanzania: Pastor Peter Mahoye shared that one of our churches in Kigoma, Tanzania was severely damaged by the heavy rains in the region. Please pray for Pastor Kita and his congregation and that the Lord will provide the funds to repair the damaged church.



Ukraine: Missionary Tammy Swailes asks us to pray for the possibility of a ceasefire in Ukraine. Let us pray for those on the front lines who have not yet found relief from the constant bombing. Also pray for the many churches Open Bible has in these areas.

Liberia: Field Director Hilary Paul praise God for the successful clearing and burning of approximately two acres of cassava, a project carried out by the national organization MEN OF VISION (M.O.V.E.), led by Brother David Lloyd. Cassava planting is already underway. The men will plant other crops among the cassava and after the harvest. We trust in God for future income from sales.

Please pray they can acquire the crushing machine and that God will speak to the hearts of the citizens so they will agree to sell the ten acres of land needed to the Liberian countryside. Negotiations continue with great optimism.
