Costa Rica: Field Director Carlos Mora shared that God has opened doors for them to evangelize the children and teaching staff of a government-sponsored daycare center.



This is a unique opportunity, as it is not easy to gain access to a government-supported institution; however, nothing is impossible for the Lord.

What makes this opportunity especially exciting is that it is not just a one-time event. They have also been granted permission to conduct a three-month discipleship program with the children.

The children's ministry of our church is coordinating and carrying out this work on a weekly basis. We thank God for this open door and pray that many lives will be reached and transformed by the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Nicaragua: Missionaries Nelson and Tirsia Gaitan shared that on Wednesday, June 3, they held a monthly meeting with all of the church's ministry workers.



A general invitation was extended to those serving in the various areas of ministry, including Sunday school teachers, teachers ministering in different neighborhoods, members of the dance and worship teams, youth leaders, and others. The purpose of this meeting was to continue learning and growing in service to God.

Thank the Lord, everyone responded to the invitation and enjoyed a wonderful time of teaching, fellowship, and prayer.

Paraguay: National Field Director Julian Paredes asks us to pray for the seven churches and their pastors in Paraguay. Uganda: Field Director John Bosco shared that they had a successful conference in Nakasongola, with 260 people attending on the first day and 329 attending on the second day. Former Field Director Rev. Jackson Mugerwa, who has served Open Bible Churches for 41 years, preached at the conference. We praise the Lord for the success of this event. Please continue to pray for the Ebola outbreak to come to an end in Uganda.
