Trinidad: Jordan Lumbard's wife, Lindsey, shared, "Yesterday, the doctors removed the tumor on the side



of Jordan's neck that was the size of his fist! They were able to remove all of the tumor that they could see, and said that if we had waited much longer, we wouldn't have been able to get it out. The surgeon had to remove two main nerves, resulting in permanent numbness on the left side of Jordan's face and neck area. The mandibular nerve that controls the left side of his bottom lip was also removed. The surgeon assured us that this will not affect his ability to speak, but he may look different when

smiling or talking. Additionally, the surgeon removed five large lymph nodes that were hidden below the tumor, which he suspects may be cancerous. This was an unfortunate and surprising find!"

Ghana/Liberia: Please pray for our missionaries Rich and Patti Kopp. Patti is currently dealing with heart issues especially related to one of the medicines she has been taking. Please keep them in your prayers as they decide the best course of action moving forward.

Paraguay: Field Director Julian Paredes asked us to pray for Marina, an elder sister of their church, who fell and fractured her thigh near the hip, a very delicate area, according to the doctors. God worked in her life with an extraordinary miracle. Last year, she suffered a stroke and her health wasn't favorable, but God intervened. She was discharged and immobile, but with therapy and much prayer, God continued to work in Sister Marina's life. She lives three blocks from the church and walks with the sisters in Christ to all



the services. Although, she was left with some after-effects God helped her walk again. Unfortunately, she fell in her home, hit her thigh very hard, and fractured it. Please also pray for the health of all our Open Bible pastors in Paraguay.

Tijuana Mexico: Missionaries Justus and Michaela shared that at the end of May, they had the privilege




