**Sierra Leone:** Field Director Milton Godwin shared that the Children's Department of Open Bible Standard Church in Congo Town recently led the Annual Thanksgiving Service. The children participated in every part of the service, including intercessory prayer, Scripture reading, memory verse recitations, poems, educational skits, and a melodrama. God moved powerfully through them, and it was wonderful to see these children growing as leaders and serving the Lord.

**Venezuela:** Venezuela recently suffered devastating damage from a powerful 7.5 magnitude earthquake. In the days following the quake, the toll has continued to rise. At least 1,450 people have lost their lives, thousands have been injured, and more than 12,000 people have been displaced.

Emergency teams and government officials are working urgently to respond, and there is hope that increased international aid and additional emergency responders will strengthen local efforts and meet critical humanitarian needs. Thousands are also reported missing— more than 46,000, according to a website where families can share information and the last known locations of their loved ones. At this time, it is not known how many of those reported missing have been found.



This disaster has also intensified the challenges Venezuela was already facing after years of economic and political hardship, placing even greater overwhelmed healthcare system.
