

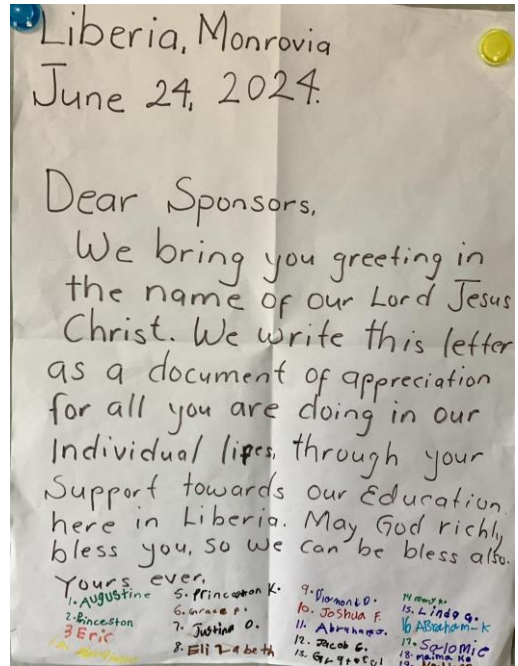
Prayer and Praise – July 03, 2024
