Uganda: Field Director Obbo John Bosco shared, "I am so thankful to the Lord for His grace, which saw us through our Annual General Conference and Thanksgiving celebration, marking the 41st anniversary of Open Bible Standard Churches of Uganda. The event took place at the Bukabi Church in Nakasongola District from June 4–6.

Our founding elders, pastors, and other leaders were recognized for their faithful service by receiving gifts such as corporate attire, goats, suits, and other tokens of appreciation.

A medical camp was also provided for two of the three days of the conference.



Despite the Ebola outbreak, the government granted us permission to proceed with the event. A total of 330 people attended, and many experienced deliverance from demonic oppression, while others were healed from various illnesses."

Liberia: Field Director Hilary Paul shared the following: "Praise God for the continued development of the coconut plantation, with about four acres of Bible Mission land cultivated and coconut seedlings now being planted. Pray for continued provision of workers and willing hearts to help sustain the farm.



Praise God for the successful Monrovia and Buchanan District Conferences. The Buchanan conference concluded with a powerful move of the Holy Spirit, with more than 30 people baptized in the Holy Spirit. Pray for more laborers as the districts continue planting churches and expanding the ministry.

Please pray for Pastor Sarah Nimeley, National Treasurer of Liberia, as she recovers from surgery and the amputation of her leg due to complications from diabetes.

Also pray for the National Leadership Training taking place July 15–18, asking for safe travel to and from the rural districts. Please pray for a timely resolution to the transportation challenges facing Field Director Hilary Paul so he can continue traveling safely and effectively to minister to and support the churches."

Venezuela: Venezuela continues to recover from the devastating twin earthquakes that struck on June 24. As rescue and recovery efforts continue, the confirmed **death toll has risen to more than 4,400 people, with over 16,700 injured and nearly 18,000 people left homeless.** Thousands of others remain missing as emergency crews continue searching through the rubble and assisting affected communities.



Emergency responders, local churches, humanitarian organizations, and government agencies continue working tirelessly to provide lifesaving assistance. International aid continues to arrive, bringing much-needed medical supplies, food, clean water, shelter, and rescue equipment to the hardest-hit communities.

This tragedy has placed even greater strain on Venezuela's already fragile healthcare system, which has struggled for years due to ongoing economic and political challenges. Hospitals and medical personnel remain overwhelmed as they care for thousands of injured survivors while facing critical shortages of supplies.



Please continue to pray for the people of Venezuela as they face the long road to recovery. Pray for continued miracles of rescue, comfort for those who have lost loved ones, provision for families displaced from their homes, strength and protection for rescue and relief workers, and for God's comfort, provision, and hope to reach every community affected by this devastating disaster.
