Papua New Guinea: Pastor Poi Eka Tunigimo shared about the outreach that took place in Popondetta



Oro Province from April 27 through May 08. Pastor Poi, his wife Joyce, Pastor Roger Wabati and Evangelist Samuel Kondango worked together to evangelize and targeted Hohorita in Sohe District. Over two hundred people recommitted their lives to the Lord and others accepted Christ as their personal Savior. Thirteen people were baptized in

water during a two-week time frame.

During the services, two men were instantly healed after prayers for healing. The first man, a young man with a broken right leg from a car accident, was able to walk freely without crutches after God healed his leg. The second man had been paralyzed for over five years and was wheel barrow-bound. The Lord completely restored him, and he was instantly able to walk again. Praise God for what He continues to do.

Kenya: Last week, Rev. Patrick Okumu, the founder of the Open Bible Churches of Kenya and Uganda, was honored during a special ceremony on July 5 for his dedication and leadership as president of the evangelical alliance and the Open Bible Churches of Kenya. The event took place at the main sports stadium in Bungoma, with approximately 1,000 attendees, including clergy representatives from around 2,000 local assemblies in Bungoma County. The governor and government officials were also present.

We congratulate Rev. Patrick Okumu on receiving this well-deserved recognition and honor. We commend him for his faithfulness in preaching the Gospel of Christ and for his leadership as president of the evangelical alliance and founder of the Open Bible Churches of Kenya and Uganda.

In Ruidoso, New Mexico, there was also had a flooding when the Ruidoso River reached a record high last week. Over 200 homes were completely destroyed and three people lost their lives after being swept away in the floodwaters.

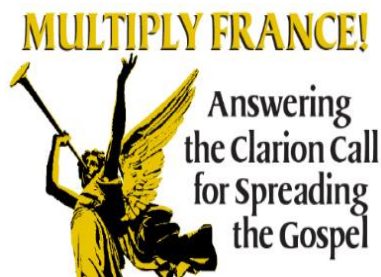
