**Grenada:** Field Director Raphael Etienne shared: “The Caribbean islands were hit by Hurricane Beryl last Monday. The most affected were Grenada and Saint Vincent. In Petite, Grenada, it is estimated that 80% of the houses and buildings were severely damaged or destroyed. About 900 people are affected and most of the island is protected. In Cannonau, Saint Vincent, 100% of the island's population of 12,600 inhabitants has been affected. It is estimated that 90% of the homes suffered significant damage or were destroyed. Our Open Bible families in these areas need your help.”

Please pray as we partner with OBSC Trinidad and Tobago to provide the urgent assistance needed to provide basic supplies such as water, food, blankets and other items to all those in need. We also need to help repair serious damage to the churches and homes of our Open Bible families in these disaster areas.
