**Peru:** Field director María Mestanza shared: "The Bible school at our Open Bible church in Florencia de Mora, Peru, is a seedbed. Pastors José and Noemí are very supportive of the children in their children's ministry. Some of them are already teenagers and have brought their parents to church.

Pray for safe travel and for the Lord's guidance and anointing in all meetings and activities.

Papua New Guinea: Field Director Joshua Essy shares that it has been a challenging year for them in Papua New Guinea because the government has not been stable. The entire country is facing an economic crisis. However, despite the challenges our Open Bible pastors and leaders have faced, they have seen significant growth in the ministry. In Chimbu province they have dedicated six new sites for church planting.



Last week, some of our leaders and pastors traveled south to the Ivingoi mission station about 30 miles and walked eight hours barefoot to conduct an evangelistic campaign there and many gave their lives to the Lord. As a result, a new church will be established there. Please pray for God to continue moving and for His provision for a new property and church building.
