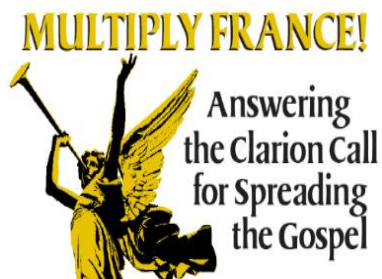
Guinea: Missionaries Tom and Sherry Moore are asking for prayers for the Kamsar church and school. Due to heavy rains, the entire compound is flooded. They have managed to obtain a rock and dirt mixture from the bauxite mining company, which is replacing their railroad tracks with new rocks. The entire church and school yard needs to be covered with this mixture to help absorb the water. So far, they have received seven loads of dirt, but they require a total of twenty truckloads of rock and dirt to prepare the yard for the reopening of school. Please pray for God's favor with the company and provision of the necessary finances to complete this work before school resumes. If the work is not completed, parents may not send their children to school, causing hardship for the staff and the church. Every time it rains, water fills the porch of Pastor Jean and Celine's house. They are seeking a miracle in this situation. Thank you for your prayers!



Uganda: Field Director Rev. Obbo John Bosco shared with us that the Otabong Open Bible Church in the Busia district recently suffered major damage due to heavy rainfall and storms. The strong winds tore the roof off the church building. Please pray that the Lord will provide funds to repair the Otabong Open Bible Church.



Trinidad: Jordan Lumbard, son of Missionaries Mike and Pam Lumbard, is continuing to receive treatments and everything seems to be healing well. Jordan and his wife, Lindsey, are seeking God's wisdom and direction for the best next step.
