Guinea: Missionaries Tom and Sherry Moore report that a devastating mudslide struck Dar-Salem, near Conakry, last Sunday following heavy rains. More than 40 people have already been confirmed dead, with many more feared missing after a second slide caused a multi-story building to collapse destroying numerous homes. Entire families were lost, and military personnel are assisting with the search and rescue efforts. Please pray for the families who have lost loved ones, those still missing, and all those affected by this tragedy.



"We praise God that the new Open Bible Church in Madina Borboffe now has its roof, windows, and doors in place, despite the rainy season! Although additional work remains, the church is progressing. We thank God for Pastor Tomas and his faithfulness in overseeing the construction and for the continued advancement of God's work in Guinea."
