Isaiah 53:5 (NIV)

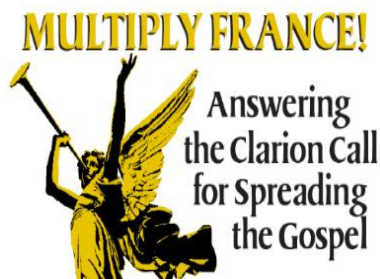
