bring items to bless the pastor and his family, such as eggs, vegetables, cooking oil, fruit drinks, and more. They take a special offering to help the church. Although they do not have a large Thanksgiving meal, they are deeply grateful for all God has done for them.

"Please be in prayer for the upcoming presidential elections in Guinea, as political unrest often occurs during these times. On a good note, we are thankful that the rains are beginning to slow down. The heavy rainfall has made it difficult to complete the renovations at the Kamsar school. Please pray that the work can be finished soon."
