Tijuana, Mexico: Please pray for the Cruz family. On Sunday, November 17, Amalia Cruz, wife of Armando Cruz, who is part of our Puente staff and interpreter, was admitted to the hospital in Chula Vista, California, after a massive stroke. The situation is very serious at the moment. We are grateful for everyone who has reached out to Puente de Amistad and the Cruz family. We continue to pray for a miracle. Please pray that Armando will be granted humanitarian parole so he can cross the border to be with his wife in the hospital.



Northern Mexico: Missionary Fayth McConnell shares that the safe house is working very well. "The safe house was built to house and help children recover after being released from prison. Lately, the number of young children and teenagers being imprisoned and released has decreased, therefore the safe house is being used for other things to glorify God.

"Problem children receive counseling from a psychiatrist and are then sent to a safe house. The leaders and team spend time listening to them as well as sharing the Word of God with everyone and also playing with them.

"We praise God, because through this program we have met many parents who are very happy about what is happening in the safe house because it is saving children's lives from going to prison. This is another way parents can hear about the Lord too!

"Please pray for the boy's prison as they do not have a prison warden at this time and only have two security officers for the entire facility. We are not allowed to go in to share the Word because of the violence that occurs there by some new prisoners. Pray that all young people are safe and not discouraged."

Sierra Leone: Field Director Milton Godwin shares, "We are praying that more souls will know Christ and that God will provide us to purchase property for the new fellowship center in Peninsula City. Both schools are also doing well. At Leicester Open Bible School, we are praying to begin the expansion of the school so that we can stop using the church building for classes. Please pray for God's provision to purchase land to start a secondary school in Congo Town."

India: Missionary Linda Wilson says: "From India all praise to the Lord for the new doors of ministry that are opening to us. We have our youth programs, small group programs, and the Spirit filling our services. Please pray that hearts continue to open to help with the necessary resources to help us continue to grow and share with God's people in India."
