Pastor David remarked, "While the cities of the world are filled with light and celebration during this time of year, we live in darkness and silence. Yet, in our communities, the churches are the only places where people can find light and joy."

Despite overwhelming challenges, the churches have developed new strategies and innovative methods to continue their ministry. Their commitment to sharing the love of Jesus is unwavering. Pastor David emphasized, "These conditions affect us, but they do not stop us. We do not stop; we continue to move forward in ministry."

In this season of adversity, Pastor David and the leaders of Open Bible Churches remain steadfast, praying that the light of Jesus will shine through the darkness and transform their nation.
