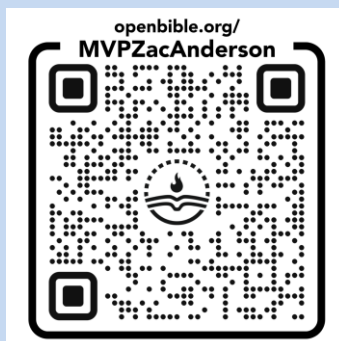
Allow Him to lead you, and He will take care of the rest.
